In MLA style you briefly credit sources with parenthetical citations in the text of your paper, and give the complete description of each source in your *Works Cited* list. The *Works Cited* list, or *Bibliography,* is a list of all the sources used in your paper, arranged alphabetically by author's last name, or when there is no author, by the first word of the title (except *A, An* or *The*).
